2019 DOG LICENSES: All dogs 7 months or older are to be licensed each year. You may also mail your fee along with proof of rabies and neutering/spaying to 470 Stage Coach Road, Millstone Twp., NJ 08510. Neutered/Spayed dog fee is \$12.00 and Non-Neutered/Non-Spayed dog fee is \$15.00. A late fee of \$10.00 PER DOG went into effect May 1, 2019 for all residents who have not renewed their dog's license for the current year.

Z19-03 Kalezic, Adrian - Block 62, Lot 31.11 located at 4 Moonlight Court consisting of 2.6 acres in the R-130 Zoning District. On November 11th, ceremonies will take place at Veterans memorials all across the US, at the exact hour- 11:00 a.m.

Veterans Day is established in the US as a national holiday to recognize our nation's Military Veterans, past and present, and the sacrifices they've made to protect our nation.

The United States Military "Code of Conduct:"

I am an American, fighting in the forces which guard my country and our way of life. I am prepared to give my life in their defense.

I will never surrender of my own free will. If in command, I will never surrender the members of my command while they still have the means to resist.

If I am captured I will continue to resist by all means available. I will make every effort to escape and to aid others to escape. I will accept neither parole nor special favors from the enemy.

If I become a prisoner of war, I will keep faith with my fellow prisoners. I will give no information or take part in any action which might be harmful to my comrades. If I am senior, I will take command. If not, I will obey the lawful orders of those appointed over me and will back them up in every way.

When questioned, should I become a prisoner of war, I am required to give name, rank, service number, and date of birth. I will evade answering further questions to the utmost of my ability. I will make no oral or written statements disloyal to my country and its allies or harmful to their cause.

I will never forget that I am an American, fighting for freedom, responsible for my actions, and dedicated to the principles which made my country free. I will trust in my God and in the United States of America.

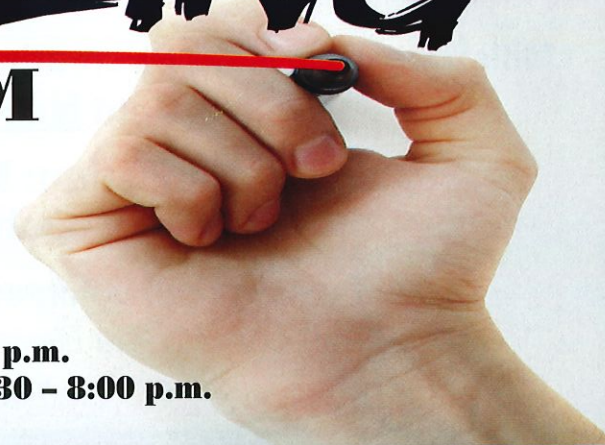

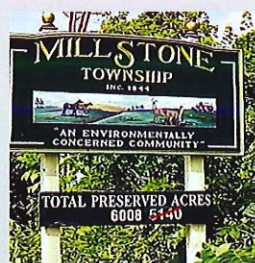

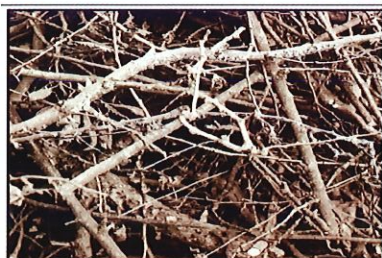
