


The Community Health Law Project is a non-profit advocacy and legal services organization with offices throughout the state.

## Programs that can help with health care costs

Imagine what you might do with extra money in your pocket. If you are eligible, Medicare Savings Programs can pay your Part B Medicare premiums, a savings of \$96.40 or \$110.50 each month.

The Low Income Subsidy provides extra help to qualified low income beneficiaries by paying the Part D monthly premium, the annual deductible, coinsurance and co-pays. Benefit levels vary by income. With LIS there is no Part D coverage gap known as the "donut hole"
