**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII (TRAFFIC), SECTION 7-3 (PARKING)
SUBSECTION 7-3.2 (PARKING PROHIBITED DURING STATE OF EMERGENCY) OF THE
REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE, COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millstone, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows (additions are underlined, and deletions are in [brackets]):

I

Chapter VII, Traffic, Section 7-3, Parking, Subsection 7-3.2, Parking Prohibited During State of Emergency, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-3 PARKING.

7-3.2 Parking Prohibited During State of Emergency.

a. Upon the declaration of an emergency by the New Jersey State Police and the adoption of a Resolution by the Township Committee, there shall be no parking upon streets or sections of streets where temporary EMERGENCY—NO PARKING signs are displayed. ~~The Chief of Police or, in his absence, the ranking Police Officer is authorized to declare an emergency and to direct the posting of EMERGENCY—NO PARKING signs when weather conditions, accidents, fires and public celebration dictate or require the avoidance of hazards or other conditions which interfere with the free flow of traffic.~~ Notification that the EMERGENCY—NO PARKING signs are being or will be posted shall be given to the operator or owner of any vehicle which has been parked prior to the posting of the signs.

II

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

III

If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

IV

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:

This Ordinance amends the procedure for declaration of emergency parking prohibition.
