- Barnegat Blitz scheduled for Wednesday, May 9, 2012 – volunteers are needed. This topic is tabled for discussion until our April meeting.

- DEP To Abandon Habitat Protections To Promote Economic Development – will this affect our T&E Species Ordinance? (Committeeman Kinsey’s email to EC) – Chairman Davis reviewed DEP summary and found that 43 new species were added and 10 species were deleted. Chairman Davis will draft a letter to Mayor & Township Committee stating that at this point the EC sees no particular impact, either positive or negative of the revised list with regards to Millstone Township. There is no impact on the enforcement of our T&E Ordinance as our ordinance does dovetail to the DEP lists and classifications.

VICE CHAIRPERSON REPORT – Doug Lischick - Absent (sent in following report)

Sign is up on the corner of Millstone Road. An EC member will lead one of the 5 groups. Flyers for the Barnegat Bay Blitz volunteers will be handed out at Stream Clean Up. Saturday, 03/31 is the Boy Scouts scheduled clean up. DPW has picked up 5 new grabbers and pokers or “extension grips” to use at the Stream clean up. Any expenses from this event will be paid from the Clean

Communities fund. Board Secretary will ask Township Clerk Maria Dellasala to order clear plastic bags to know which bags contain recyclables. Board Secretary will also advise Leslie Breckell of the Watershed. 2012 flyer received from Watershed on 2-23-2012. Publicity update – Clean Communities to cover cost of Examiner ads, refreshments. To date the EC has received good publicity for this event.

Bug ID held Saturday, March 10, 2012 – EC had insufficient samples this cold day. Silt and fine sand found but water was clear. If silt is found next time EC feels there is a change in the stream.
