

Planning Board 3-13-13 Meeting

Approval of Minutes: February 13, 2013

Resolutions:

P12-08 Perl Acres South – Block 55, Lot 2. Located on Route 526. Consisting of 158.2 acres. Zone has changed from R-130 to the RU-P zone. Applicant received Preliminary Major Subdivision approval on 6-25-03 to create a 43-residential lot subdivision with 2 lots for Township dedication. Final Approval was granted and a Resolution memorialized on 4-11-07. Applicant had received two one-year extensions of time and a total of two additional one-year extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-52b. The Board granted an additional three (3) month extension of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-52b, running from 4-11-13 ending on 7-10-13. Zone has changed and is presently RU-P.

P13-03 St. Joseph’s Church – Block 41, Lot 1. Located on Sweetman’s Lane and Stillhouse Road. Consisting of 30.38 acres located in the RU-P zone. Applicant received Preliminary and Final Major Subdivision approval on 1-14-09 to create a 3 lot subdivision. Applicant sought and received first one-year extension of time which ran on 1-14-11; second one year extension of time was sought and granted and ran through 1-13-13. Applicant sought and received its third one-year extension of time in order to perfect the subdivision. No zone change has occurred.

Homestead Credit Information

Most eligible homeowners will receive their 2011 homestead benefit as a credit applied to property tax bills in August 2013. Those homeowners who either sold their home prior to filing the homestead benefit application, or whose principal residence was a unit in a co-op or continuing care retirement community will be issued a benefit in the form of a check or direct deposit in August 2013. Tenants will not receive a 2011 rebate. The deadline for filing 2011 applications was December 14, 2012.

MEMORIAL DAY PARADE



Important Reasons to Vaccinate Your Child

Immunizations can save your child's life. Because of advances in medical science, your child can be protected against more diseases than ever before. Some diseases that once injured or killed thousands of children, have been eliminated completely and others are close to extinction-primarily due to safe and effective vaccines. One example of the great impact that vaccines can have is the elimination of polio in the United States. Polio was once America's most-feared disease, causing death and paralysis across the county, but today, thanks to vaccination, there are no reports of polio in the United States.

Immunization protects others you care about. Children in the U.S. still get vaccine-preventable diseases. In fact, we have seen resurgences of measles and whooping cough (pertussis) over the past few years. In 2010 the U.S. had over 21,000 cases of whooping cough reported and 26 deaths, most in children younger than 6 months. In 2011, 222 people were reported to have measles in the U.S.-that's more than any year since 1996. Unfortunately, some babies are too young to be completely vaccinated and some people may not be able to receive certain vaccinations due to severe allergies, weakened immune systems from conditions like leukemia, or other reasons. To help keep them safe, it is important that you and your children who are able to get vaccinated are fully immunized. This not only protects your family, but also helps prevent the spread of these diseases to your friends and loved ones.

Vaccination is very safe and effective. Vaccines are only given to children after a long and careful review by scientists, doctors, and healthcare professionals. Serious side effects following vaccination such as severe allergic reaction are very rare. The disease-prevention benefits of getting vaccines are much greater than the possible side effects for almost all children.

Immunizations can save your family time and money. Some vaccine-preventable diseases can result in prolonged disabilities and can take a financial toll because of lost time at work, medical bills or long-term disability care. In contrast, getting vaccinated against these diseases is a good investment and usually covered by insurance. Under the Affordable Care Act, the new health care law, many insurers are required to cover certain preventive services at no cost to you, including vaccines for children from birth to age 18 years. Additionally, the "Vaccine for Children's" (VFC) program is a federally funded program that provides vaccines at no cost to children from low income families. MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE TO PREVENT ALCHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE HAS A NEW STRATEGIC PLAN UNDERWAY

Earlier in the year, Helen Varvi - Millstone Township Alliance Coordinator - had the opportunity to attend the 2013 CADCA Leadership Forum in Washington D.C. This conference provided a number of opportunities to learn about current trends in prevention, listen to nationally known speakers and to meet our representatives in Congress on a special Capitol Hill Day.

Starting the week with a special Prevention Day was an opportunity to connect with prevention specialists across the country to share ideas and to learn more about environmental approaches to prevention. A workshop entitled "Strategies with Power to Change Communities" was a good foundation for the changes that will be occurring over the coming years with our own Municipal Alliance.

Over the next few months, our Alliance will be reaching out to community members, organizations, school personnel and faith-based congregations to identify the priorities for prevention in our community.

Please consider participating in one of these upcoming meetings. Information and concerns you have regarding alcohol and other drug use in our community is valuable information to share as we create a new strategic plan that will guide our efforts for the next five years.


