

**MILLSTONE TOWNSHIP PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION

- **Eagle Scout Project** - Scott Keleher

Scott Keleher discussed the Eagle Scout project he had previously proposed to the commission. He plans to install a bulletin board at the Brandywine soccer complex. It will be located in front of the bathrooms in the mulch section of the landscaping. The bulletin board will be identical to the one located in Abate Park. Decorative stones and perennial flowers will also be planted at the base of the sign. He is relying on the flowers and bulletin board to be donated. It was discussed how the name on the sign should read and the type of wood the project would be. It was suggested he speak with Ken Gann, supervisor of Dept of public works and inquire about installing the sign in regards to the frost line. The commissioners signed off verbally on the project and advised to have his scout master approve the proposed project. He plans to attend Augusts' meeting with an update as he will be out of town for July's recreation meeting.
