NATIONAL PANCREATIC CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, in 2015, an estimated 48,960 people will be diagnosed with Pancreatic Cancer in the United States and it is estimated that 40,560 deaths will occur from the disease in 2015;

WHEREAS, Pancreatic Cancer is one of the deadliest cancers, is currently the fourth leading cause of cancer death in the United States, and is projected to become the second by 2020;

WHEREAS, Pancreatic Cancer is the only major cancer with a five-year relative survival rate in the single digits at just 7%;

WHEREAS, when symptoms of Pancreatic Cancer present themselves, it is generally late stage, and 73% of Pancreatic Cancer patients die within the first year of their diagnosis while 93% of Pancreatic Cancer patients die within the first five years;

WHEREAS, with research, there is hope and The Lustgarten Foundation supports research to find a cure for Pancreatic Cancer, facilitates dialogue within the medical and scientific community, and educates the public about the disease;

COMMENTS FROM THE DAIS:

C/Grbelja shared with residents that one of the individuals responsible for burglarizing homes in Millstone was caught due to an observant and proactive resident. A Millstone resident observed an individual walking through his development. The resident followed the individual, pursuing him and the others in their vehicle. The resident provided this information as well as the car's license plate number to the police. The Manalapan Police made an arrest within 45 minutes. It goes to say that it is very important for residents to pay attention to what's happening in their neighborhood. C/Grbelja described the same type of entrance to the home being made as other burglaries recently occurring in Millstone. She described one particular case in which the doorbell was rung at the home of an elderly resident but she did not answer the door. The burglars broke through the door as the resident was standing there. The resident had called 911 and the police had actually closed down the area trying to locate the car. The next day in a different part of town, some of the same group of burglars did the same thing but were driving a different car. Police apprehended the individuals. Hopefully, this will lead to additional arrests. If you see something, pursue it. This resident went above and beyond and if he didn't, they may still be out there burglarizing homes throughout the town.

M/Kinsey states that we received a call today about the body found in Perrineville Lake park, the gentleman was missing for several months. He was not in the system.

C/Kuczinski states someone has to report him missing first.

C/Grbelja states there is always communication between the NJSP and the Township Committee.

C/Dorfman states that this was very unusual circumstance.

C/Masci states that sometimes we like to get information sooner than we can, we have to wait if it is still an active investigation.

C/Dorfman states that the Sheriff's Office has an ID program that may be useful to some residents.

M/Kinsey states if you see something be vigilant. M/Kinsey drove past Abate Park after midnight there were 2 cars in the park - he called the State Police and they were very quickly on the scene.

C/Grbelja states that some of the break-ins back up to the woods with easy access, they come in grab jewelry from master bedrooms.

C/Masci states last year there was a heroin epidemic, which stems from oxycodone epidemic they must steal from family and have no problem about staling from residents. I saw a car parked on Fawn Way, which was unusual and called the NJSP - always better safe than sorry.

C/Grbelja states that our Drug Alliance has statistics that say on 3% marijuana users end up heroin user, 2% drinkers end up heroin user, 15% cocaine users end up heroin user however 40% prescription users end up heroin user, the biggest problem stems from prescription pain killers and xanax.

M/Kinsey reminds everyone that on Wednesday 11/11/15 the Veterans Council will hold its annual Veterans Day Ceremony at 11:00am, come out and support our troops.
