CORRESPONDENCE

- Monmouth County Historic Preservation Commission to Commissioner Butch
 - Commissioner Butch received a letter awarding HPC with \$6,000 for Monmouth County Preservation Grant
 - Grant is for refurbishing the siding on the Thomas Baird Homestead
 - Town will put in \$10,000 to match the \$6,000 we're getting from this grant
 - FMTHRP will provide \$4,000 for us
 - Need to have a total of \$20,000 for this project

 - b. Hopefully next meeting the potential new members will be approved
- 2. Update on Zoom Information

 - b. Grant was submitted by the HPC through the Township and supported by the FMTHRP

 - a. Grant is for updating and refurbishing the siding on the Thomas Baird Homestead \$6,000
 - b. Grant will be awarded to us at an awards ceremony
 - i. Will be held at Freehold Hall of Records Annex Building
 - 1. Kevin Abernathy will be attending the ceremony on behalf of the Township to accept the grant
- 5. 2023 Grants To Apply To
 - a. Heritage Tourism Grant
 - i. HPC and FMTHRP will be co-applicants
 - b. NI Historic Capital Grant 1 or 2
 - i. HPC will be applying for this grant
 - ii. If we ask for \$150,000 or less, we will apply for Capital Grant 1, but if it is more then we will apply for Capital Grant 2

- 1. HPC is getting estimate to see how much it will cost to restore the current Municipal Building (National Register and State Listed)
 - a. Barton Ross has been assisting on building material estimates
- c. NJ Historic Capital Grant and Heritage Tourism Grant allows recipients to use 20% of awarded amount to hire professionals for their service
