ORDINANCE NO. 23-12 INTRODUCED: 07-05-2023 ADOPTED: 07-19-2023

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE AND APPROPRIATING \$2,025,000 FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, authorizes various capital improvements, including the (a) acquisition of truck for Department of Public Works; (b) various road and paving improvements, including but not limited to Millstone Road north of Sweetmans Lane to Route 33, Backbone Hill Road from Schoolhouse Road to Charleston Spring Road, Municipal Court House, Olde Noah Hunt Road, Bruere Drive, Holdman Place, Stevenson Avenue, Clayton Drive and Vanarsdale Circle, for the Township of Millstone, to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.
- Section 2. The amount of \$2,025,000 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance and which amount was funded from two grants in the amount of \$305,000 from New Jersey Department of Transportation for Millstone Road, \$219,420 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation for Backbone Hill Road and \$1,500,580 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the remainder of the improvements, for a total amount of \$2,025,000.
- Section 3. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Township determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Millstone may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- <u>Section 4</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.
