Chairman Morris opened and closed the meeting to the public at 7:49.

Jackson Sports Complex:

C/Morris, C/Simels, and Committeeman Kuczinski had a meeting with the developer of the Jackson Sports Complex. He presented a plan with multiple turf fields, baseball fields, indoor complex and a couple hotels. The developer is looking to possibly partner with recreation. C/Morris feels from a recreation stand point the recreation programs would not have a need for their facility but did note there may be a usage for the travel programs. There has been no commitment from either side. The developer also inquired about having the ability to use Millstone Park fields. C/Morris noted that the property was purchased using some green acres funding and that certain rules will apply. A time line for construction was not provided.

Basketball:

C/Adornetti noted there are three weeks left in the season. Chairman Morris asked about the loss of the middle school gyms this year. Secretary Peerboom noted that the Board of Education was able to return three Saturdays for recreation basketball due to cancellations. The season has been going well.

Summer Camp:

Summer recreation camp will be held July 2 through August 3rd. School ends on Wednesday June 20th this year. Recreation needs a few days to prepare the school before camp begins. The camp director inquired about the starting salaries for summer camp counselors. Chairman Morris requested we prepare the assumptions of the cost and he will present to our liaison.

Lacrosse:

C/Skowronski noted that registration is closed but currently will still accept some registrations. They ordered an extra few uniforms to accommodate any late registrations. Lacrosse will be using indoor gym time at Sportika during the month of February. It is optional for all players. During the month of March they will move into the school gyms.

Township Parks:

The Township is currently reviewing budget items and the Rocky Brook tennis courts are included to be repaired. Recreation has made a recommendation that all four courts be resurfaced. The fields at Millstone Park will be reseeded as soon as the weather breaks. Additional work needs to be completed including the landscaping.

Seeing no new business Chairman Morris made a Motion to adjourn and C/Adornetti offered a Second and by unanimous vote, the Meeting adjourned at 8:23 p.m.
